- Welcome to the last meeting of an outstanding Year. Olympic is leading the city in violent crime reduction. 61% down in homicides; 57% down in rape; 22.4% down in Robberies; 23% down in aggravated assaults, this is significant difference in ONE year. Police Commission said Olympic is the model of community outreach and community policing.

- 7th homicide of the year at Pico and Orchard on homeless man, no evidence but people knows and we will solve this murder. Solved 8 homicides, arrested a man in NY on a 1987 murder using DNA and good police work
- Please sign up for elections that take place at next months meeting
- Arrested 22,600 more people this year over last year
- During Christmas Season Please be careful about drinking and driving
- 127 crimes last year the 2 weeks following Thanksgiving this year only 78 crimes.
